EGATCA RULES – 2014

Lead Line – Open to riders (7) Years of age or under. Western Attire must be worn. To be judged on suitability of mount and presentation. Rider May be asked to jog.
Off Lead – Handler to stay next to horse.

Novice Rider – Open to beginner riders of all ages or green horses 3 yrs. & younger

Open Rider – Open to experienced riders over the age of (12).

Jack Benny Riders – Open to all riders over the age of (35)

Western Pleasure Divisions

Western Dressage – Open To All riders, readers allowed, rules posted on show grounds

Novice Western Pleasure – Open to beginner riders of any age or green horses 3 yrs & younger

Open Western Pleasure – Open to experienced riders of any age

Jack Benny Western Pleasure – open to riders over (35) yrs. of age

ABERDEEN STABLES RULES – 2014

Negative Coggins dated January 1, 2014 or later. All pets must be leashed and /or restrained at all times.

Aberdeen Stables Show Committee, volunteers and EGATCA will not be responsible for any loss or injury to any person, horse or property incurred on any show grounds.

All riders aged 18 and younger **MUST** wear protective SEI approved helmets while mounted on show grounds. Proper attire and shoes or boots with heels required.

NO TANK TOPS OR SHORTS. NO EXCEPTIONS!!!

The Show Committee (s) reserves the right to combine, cancel, move classes, change officials or adjust the time schedule if necessary.

There will be one minute ring call for each class, strictly enforced! Failure to respond will result in elimination.

NO REFUNDS AFTER ENTRY WITHOUT VERIFICATION OF VETERINARIAN.

DIRECTIONS: From 81 North, take 81 N to 380 S toward Mt. Pocono/Milford. Take Moscow Exit, left onto route 690 E. Follow Rt. 690 into town. You will come to a T at Route 435, turn right onto Rt. 435 S. Make first left under the underpass continuing on Route 690 E. ** Go to Stop sign, go straight through, this becomes Aberdeen Road. We are about a mile and a half on left. For parking trailers, pass Aberdeen Stables, go to four corner intersection and turn left. You will see signs. From 380 North, take Gouldsboro Exit onto Route 435 N. Follow Rt. 435 N into Moscow. Make right turn under underpass onto Route 690 E. ** Follow above directions.

EGATCA DIVISION RULES 2014

Lead Line – Open to riders (7) years of age and under. Proper Attire must be worn. Judged on suitability of mount and presentation. Rider may be asked to jog.

Must consist of: Lead line (7) years and younger.

Off Lead – Handler to stay next to horse.

Novice Rider – Open to beginner riders of all ages in their first or second year of showing and green horses, 3 yrs. of age and younger. Riders must wear proper attire. Riders under 18 years of age are required to wear SEI approved safety helmets.

Must consist of: Novice Western Pleasure – W/J/L, or W/J

Novice Trail

Novice Western Riding

Jack Benny Rider – Open to all riders 35 years of age and older. Riders must wear proper attire.

Must consist of: Jack Benny Pleasure – W/J/L, or W/J

Jack Benny Trail

Jack Benny Western Riding

Open Rider – Open to experienced riders over the age of 12. Riders must wear proper attire. Riders under the age of 18 are required to wear SEI approved safety helmets.

Must consist of: Open Western Pleasure – W/J/L, or W/J

Gymkhana - Novice – Open to beginner riders in their first or second year of competing or green horses 3 years of age and younger. Riders must wear proper attire. Riders under 18 years of age must wear SEI approved safety helmets.

Must consist o : Novice Cloverleaf Barrels

Novice Keyhole

Novice Poles

Gymkhana – Open – Open to experienced riders over the age of 12. Proper attire required. Riders under the age of 18 must wear SEI approved safety helmets. Points are on the horse.

Must consist of: Open Cloverleaf Barrels

Open Keyhole

Open Poles

Gymkhana – Jack Benny – Open to riders 35 years of age and older. Proper attire must be worn. Points are on the rider.

Must consist of: Jack Benny Cloverleaf Barrels

Jack Benny Keyhole

Jack Benny Poles

Open Driving – This division is open to any breed or type of horse or pony, including Draft Horses. The division is open to exhibitors of any age and is a two wheel cart class. Drivers under 18 years of age, must wear a safety helmet and be accompanied by an adult attendant. Exhibitors must be neatly attired. **For points to count, participants must be entered in two of the three classes.**

Open Pleasure Driving – To be shown both ways of the ring at a flat walk and a road gait. May be asked to halt and back. Exhibitors will be asked to reverse on the diagonal across the ring at the direction of the ring steward.

Obstacle Driving – A pattern will be posted (1) one hour before the start of the division. Obstacles will include such things as mailboxes, cones, tarps or other materials to cross over, and a walk-in and back-out with poles or white lines as markers.

Reinsmanship – This is an equitation class to be shown both ways of the ring at a flat walk, park gait, and a road gait. May be asked to halt and back. Exhibitors will be asked to reverse on the diagonal across the ring at the direction of the ring steward.

NOTICE - These events are for fun only, Points will not count toward any other organization shows. Our point system will count toward YEAR END prizes awarded by EGATCA. Our goal is to offer an affordable alternative, for folks who just want to enjoy some family fun and friendly competition with their horse.

Entry Fees
